



Friends 20th Anniversary 2015

This year marks 20 years of 'Friends' fundraising at Sacred Heart. Fundraising has always been a part of the life of a Catholic school and provides the 'extras' for our children - no event is complete without a raffle! I have dug into records, my photos/memories and written a brief overview of our church, school and 'Friends'.

Background

The Parish of Sacred Heart can be traced back to 1865, when the residents would hear Mass in the stable loft above the Star & Garter pub in Tyldesley, said by the first Parish Priest Father Dawber. In 1868 Lord Lilford granted the parishioners a piece of land in Hindsford. Donations and voluntary local labour help build the 400 person church and it was opened in 1869 - the mother church serving Hindsford, Tyldesley, Atherton, Boothstown and Astley. In 1888 the foundation stone was laid for a school, on the site adjacent to the church, for the children of the area. In 1955 the new infant department was opened at the end of Lodge Lane - the present school site.

In 1994 Governors decided to combine both departments at the 'Infant' site. This decision was made in the light of the poor condition of the 'Junior' school building, lack of funding for repair - in those days the Parish was responsible for the school building repair and maintenance - split site logistics and running costs. Governors petitioned the local Authority to help transfer all pupils to one site. We were successful, but had to raise £10 000 urgently. The then new head, Mrs Stewart, formed an official fundraising body, i.e. 'Friends of Sacred Heart', to help raise the school contribution. The Governors, school, parents, children, family, friends and parishioners pulled together to reach our target and records show the first monies were paid in March 1995. Building and dedication took place in 1996, with all the children on one site. The foundation stone for the demolished junior school was placed near the front entrance to the present school. The 'Friends' success would continue to provide money in the future for schools' disposal.
