

Childcare vouchers can be used to reduce cost to £6 per day.




Mystery Readers



Should we ever need to evacuate school, our designated contact points are Hindsford CE School and Hindsford Day Nursery. Our external exits are at either corner of the playground. Our primary exit is the gate in the corner of KS2's playground and we then move up, along school's path between the fence and houses – marked with a yellow arrow (The area we've recently maintained). Alternatively, we exit via the new gate we have had installed, located near KS1's playground, up to the main road.
