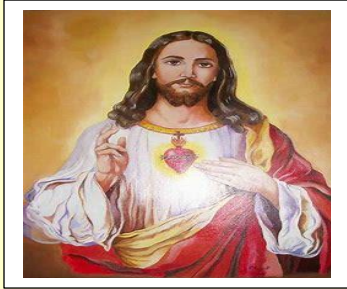


Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School
