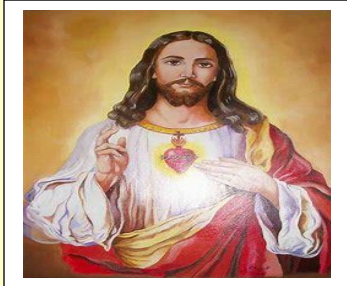


# Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School
