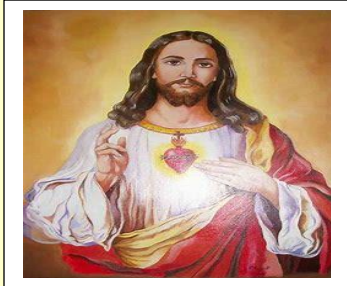

Parents and family members welcome to join us. Y5 will lead the readings and Y4 will lead the music.

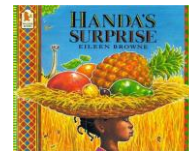
## Recommended Read
