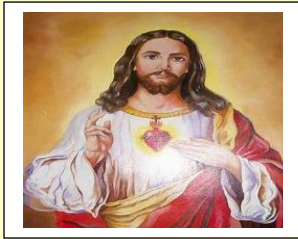

### **Medicines in School:**

A new policy has been sent to Governors for approval. This will be implemented after the Easter Holidays.

The main changes, take note of national changes of policy and are as follows:

The school will not accept or administer:

- Medicines that are to be administered 3 times per day (unless the child is attending after school club and will not return home immediately after 3:30pm, or attending a residential visit);
- Piriton (must be prescribed or advised by a medical practitioner as part of an identified medical need - hayfever etc ... );
- Paracetamol eg Calpol, or aspirin. (must be prescribed);
- Creams for dry skin (must be prescribed or advised by a medical practitioner as part of an identified medical need - eczema etc ...).

Please note, the sections in brackets allow for those practitioners who prefer it if their patients purchase over the counter medicine, as it is cheaper than prescribing on the NHS. In these cases, we will accept the medicines as a Health Care Plan will already have been completed.
