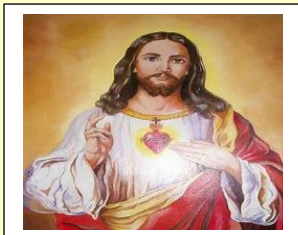


# Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School

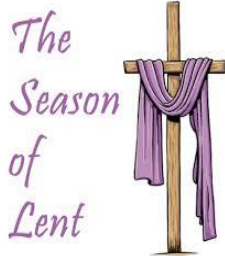
### **SEMH - Nurses**
