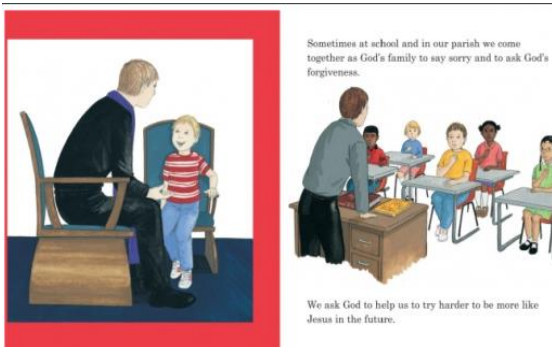




**Religious Education-

Reconciliation- Inter-relating**

Focuses on the love, compassion and forgiveness of God the Father revealed in Jesus and poured out by the Spirit to bring forgiveness through the Sacrament.





KS1: Create a story board to **retell** the different stages of 'The Sacrament of Reconciliation'.



Think of the things you are sorry about.  
You ask God to forgive you.  
You tell the priest.  
The priest tells you your sins are forgiven in Jesus' name.

KS2: Research the Act of contrition. Create a card or gift to make a mends with someone **giving reasons** as to why you have chosen this act.
