Last time, we thought about high and low pitch sounds using a piano to help us.

This time, you are going to play a song using three notes, then write one for yourself. I used this piano again.

Have a listen to a song that uses three notes. It is called Hot Cross Buns.



This is what hot cross buns look like

I have played it for you on the piano, have a look.

It only uses the notes C, D and E and it goes like this

E D C E D C CCCC DDDD E D C

See if you can get someone to help you to learn to play it on the piano. As you can see, if you press the red circle you can record it. Press the blue square to stop recording then press the blue triangle to listen to your playing!


Now it's your turn!

Let's Get Creative!

Now, it's time for you to use the piano to compose a song of your own using the rhythms we made last week.

Compose means that you are going to make up and record your song using the notes C D and E

Last week we used **flower** and **bean** to make our own rhythms.



I'm going to add pitch to my rhythm. This means that I'm going to use different sounds that are higher or lower.

Peer leaves his home just like Jack. He finds himself in a mysterious cave.




He is captured by trolls who take him to their King. He escapes and at the start of the music, Peer begins to sneak away.
