

**Inclusive Quality First Teaching**

Including;

- \***all staff** efficiently identifying and meeting the needs of all learners
- \*close liaison between **all staff** teaching the learner.

many...**Effective Inclusive Classrooms**

The teacher may notice some difficulty. It may also show up in the tracking data.

The teacher will inform **EW** (Inclusion Manager) and/or **HA** (SEN TA).

Parents may be informed and consulted. **EW** may consult IMcD (Headteacher) on the best way to move forward.

**Specific Intervention/Low Level Support**

A discussion occurs about removing the barriers to learning and possible strategies to support the learner between Class Teacher, **EW** and **HA**. An in-class strategy for the Class TA may begin.

**Specific Intervention/  
Targeted Support**

For some pupils a more targeted approach may be required. Class Teacher, **EW** and **HA** will have a further discussion and a programme of specific interventions formulated. Delivered by **HA**. (**EW**).

**External Agency Advice**

Advice is sought from TESS (usually) first. EP assessment may follow.

Pupil is included on the SEN List when the support begins.

If the pupil's progress continues to be of concern, the pupil is referred to an External Agency. This is usually the Specialist Teachers from TESS in the first instance. In a very small number of cases, a referral may go to the Educational Psychology Service.

A detail IEP or Individual Learning Plan is formulated by **EW**.

**HA** delivers withdrawal Interventions. Examples include;

1. Short targeted interventions for Specific Learning Difficulties e.g. Dyslexia type learning needs.
2. Significant withdrawal for English and/or Maths may be required. A parallel curriculum to the rest of the class is devised.
