



Assessments Summer Term 2024

Week Commencing 13th May:

End of Key Stage 2 Statutory Standard Assessment Tests – Year 6 children. When we return, I will send information and the processes schools must follow when a child is sick during the day of the test.

Week Commencing 3rd June: First week back after half term break.

Schools have 2 weeks to administer the Statutory MTC (Multiplication Tables Check) to pupils in Year 4. **We aim to administer these, week commencing 10th June.**

Week Commencing 10th June:

The statutory Year 1 Phonics Screening Check (PSC) to be administered.

The Statutory Year 2 re-sits of the PSC – only those children who did not pass or sit it in Year 1.

Week Commencing 17th June:

Y2 Optional (Highly recommended to be completed by the DfE) Assessments – Reading, Maths and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

Y3 / Y4 / Y5 – NFER Summer Term Assessments in Reading, Maths and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

Please note that for any statutory tests (SATs, PSC, MTC) a monitoring visit may be undertaken by the Local Authority, who have a responsibility to visit 25% of schools each year for all statutory assessments. In previous years we have been visited for the KS2 SATs and PSC. The outcome of these visits have been that school has robust systems in place to ensure the integrity of the tests and that the tests are administered in accordance with the outlined expectations.
