## Dear Parents / Carers,

Next week is the End of Key Stage 2 Standard Assessment Tests (Y6 SATs). Our Year 6 children have been working very hard towards this important week. We wish them the best of luck next week. I am sure they will all do well.

If you haven't seen the Facebook post - 'Thank You' all for your support in ensuring your child attends school. We have received a certificate as we are in the top 10% of FFT similar schools. Well done all.

Yesterday, I had my termly meeting with the local authority statutory officer. As part of this meeting, the LA officer reviewed our data and was delighted with the progress we have made collectively to improve school attendance across all groups of children who are monitored.
