Dear Parents / Carers,

It has been an extremely busy week in school. If you've contacted school please be patient awaiting your reply. Throughout Tuesday and Wednesday many staff members were working constantly with the inspectors and so we haven't had the opportunities to respond in as timely a manner as we would usually.

Well done to our Year 1 (some Year 2) children who have taken the Phonics Screening Check this week. We are very proud of your efforts.

Well done to our Year 4 children who have undertaken the Multiplication Tables Check this week. You too have worked really hard and we are proud of your efforts as well.

Next week is assessment week for all children in Years 1 - 5. We know you will do your best. The tests only check against the work you have been taught throughout this year and earlier years too. So there's enough questions for everyone to do well. Tests will take place in Reading, Spelling, Grammar and Mathematics.

Children in Year 6 are finishing off their curriculum learning over the coming weeks. We still have to report nationally our Teacher Assessment Grades. The work and home learning tasks between now and the 26th June are vitally important for staff to finalise their assessments of the children. These grades, along with the SATs results are used when measuring progress and setting targets throughout High School.

The Year 5 residential payments on Arbor have now gone live. Apologies for the delay in this being uploaded.

Thank you to the pupils from St. Mary's High School. You have been a great help in school this week. I hope you've gained the experience you hoped for.
