Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope this week's newsletter finds you well.

Next Friday (10th July), your child should be bringing home their end of year report. As previously shared, these are factual documents, and read as such, as they are based on assessment data and your child's work throughout the year against the national standards. They are not a narrative of all that your child has done and achieved throughout the year. There is set criteria which schools have to adhere to when reporting to parents.

Your child's attainments in English and Maths should not come as a shock to most parents, as staff have reported this to you twice during the year at the Parents' Evening and Pupil-Parent Conference.

The Greater Depth Standard is only applicable in Reading, Writing and Maths. This standard does not exist for other subject areas.

For those pupils who are working below Age-Related Expectations, (typically those with an EHCP), please don't compare your children against their peers and the national standards as your child(ren) are on a different pathway / journey.

Attendance Percentage Comments are those used nationally and by the Department for Education. They are as follows:

97% - 100% - above national average

94% - 96.9% - In line with national average

90% - 93.9% - below national average

50% - 89.9% - persistently absent

<50% - Severely Absent

I hope the above information is useful to support you prior to you receiving your child's report.
